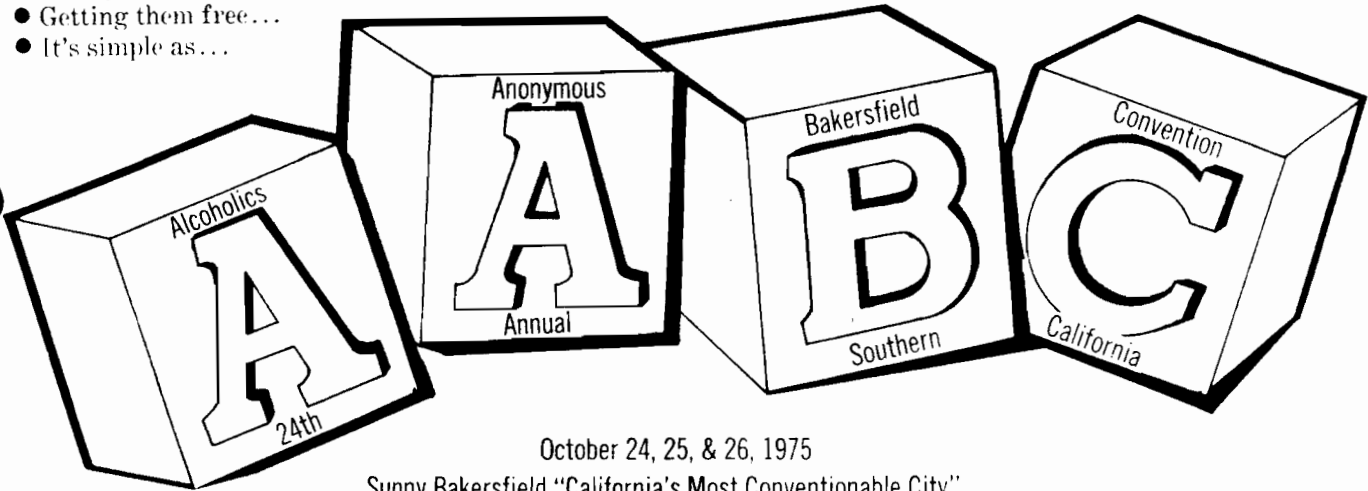

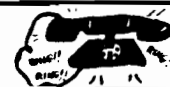
Nominations will be held next month for four members of the Service Board whose terms of office have expired. Election is in November.

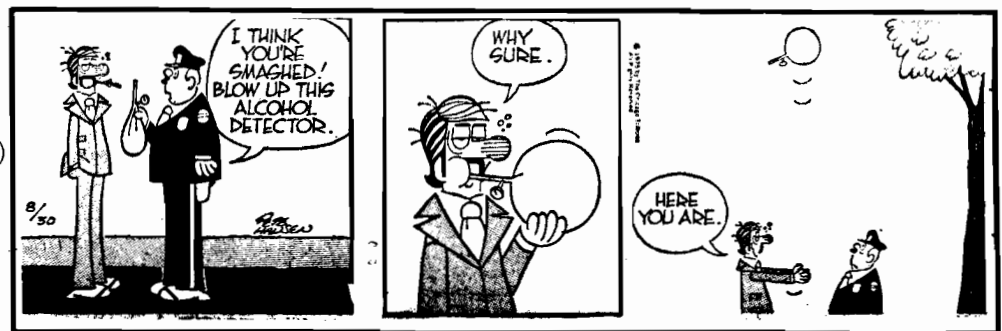

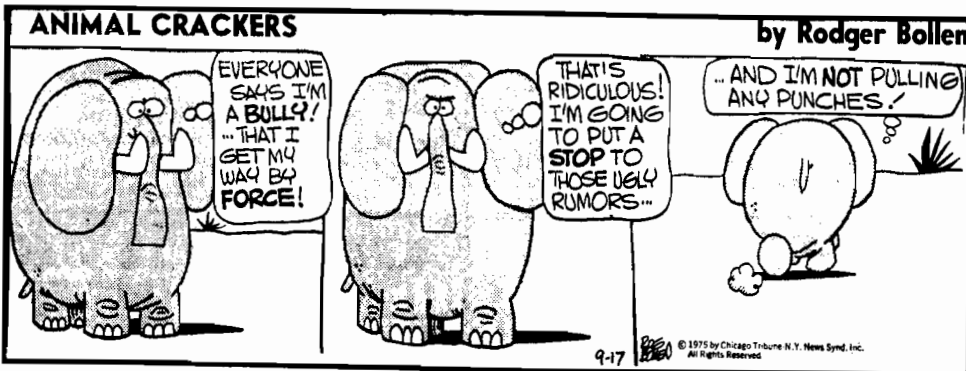

worse. The idea of calling AA had been suggested by my wife. That was good enough reason not to call. But desperation forced me to look up the number and set into motion a series of events that have changed my life in a way I could never have dreamed possible. Slowly things began to get better.

By following a few simple steps, life became an ally instead of an enemy. Problems were situations that I was able to face for the first time in my life. The trip became enjoyable, and I no longer was obsessed with the destination. It has been possible to filter back into the main stream of life and become a responsible member of society.

I was in a great expanse of ocean with no help in sight. Drowning was a certainty. Suddenly on the horizon a ship appeared and it headed straight for me. The Captain heard my cries for help and stopped to pick me up. The people on board were very happy and eager to help,

their hands reached out to me. I was saved from certain death. The ship is AA, the Captain, God, the destination, saving as many helpless victims as possible. We are all in the same boat.

Many people in many places all over the world are at this moment answering the call from the man or woman who is seeking a way out of the personal hell that has been a constant companion.

I tried to think back to that night a few years ago.
