INTERGROUP HIGHLIGHTS...  
The first meeting of the Orange Co. Intergroup Association for 1976 was held January 13, at Central Office. 55 Intergroup Representatives were in attendance along with other interested members of the Fellowship.

Don M., Vice-Chairman, explained the plans for the next F.R.E.S.H. meeting to be held March 22nd.

Gordon M., Treasurer, advised in his report that total group contributions for 1975 were less than those received in 1974.

Jack S., Central Office, explained the Central Office statistical report for the past five years, copies of which were passed out to those in attendance, and which showed a growth in total calls to Central Office and T.A.B. from 8,432 in 1971 to 38,663 in 1975.

Jim S., Public Relations, presented data associated with his various contacts with the community. Among these was a presentation of the "Tel Law" program being introduced by the Bar Association and the Legal Aid Society. The "Tel Law" program provides a free answering service associated with legal problems.

Dan F., Group Relations, explained a program being prepared to improve communication with those groups not currently active in Intergroup.

Jim H., Institutional, explained various activities and advised that it is planned to have Sarah P., the General Service Office Institutional Committee Chairman attend the Hospital and Institutional Conference in Fresno, May 7, 8, and 9th, 1976.

Peggy F. announced the next special event which is the 14th Anniversary Central Office Open House, February 14th and 15th. A signup sheet was passed out to take back to the groups for donations of finger sandwiches and cookies.

Your chairman advised that he had met with personnel of the Costa Mesa Step House and was assured that the groups at that location would have a secretary and that any donation after expenses would come from the groups and not from the Step House. Based on this information the groups would not be deleted from the Orange County Directory.

Your chairman advised that at the Jan. 11th Gen. Assembly an action item "Is there a need for a questionnaire directed to young people to assist public information speakers at high schools and colleges" was presented with requests for comments and opinions based on experience from the Orange County Intergroup Association. . . . Repeatedly we read and hear of the work being done and the dollars spent on finding the causes of alcoholism. Certainly, we can all wish more were known about the causes...but I am extremely grateful that I was directed to the remedy. In the same manner that digitalis is prescribed to deal with the symptoms of heart disease and insulin is given to deal with diabetes, AA is my method to deal with my compulsive compulsion of alcohol.

While no one has taken even an oblique shot at AA's program of recovery, there seems to be a tendency to downgrade remedial treatment as temporary and superficial.

It seems to me that any treatment of the alcoholic must be remedial. There is no present value in getting at the causes and correcting them, because the net result of such an endeavor would be to enable the person to drink normally. Any therapy devoted to such a goal is unrealistic, I think most of us in AA would agree. There is no present cure for alcoholism, the only remedy is to stop drinking, total abstinence.

Amazingly, the more of us who stop taking the first drink, as a remedy for our alcoholism, the more we know about why we drank in the first place. How about that! .....Gordon F. (Tustin.)
