"You are not selected because of exceptional talents, and be careful always, if success attends your efforts, not to ascribe to personal superiority that to which you can lay claim only by virtue of my gift. If I had wanted learned men to accomplish this mission, the power would have been entrusted to the physician and scientist. If I had wanted eloquent men, there would have been many anxious for the assignment, for talk is the easiest used of all talents with which I have endowed mankind. If I had wanted scholarly men, the world is filled with better qualified men than you who would be available. You were selected because you have been the outcasts of the world and your long experience as drunkards has made or should make you humbly alert to the cries of distress that come from the lonely hearts of alcoholics everywhere.

"Keep ever in mind the admission you made on the day of your profession to A A, namely that you are powerless and that it was only with your willingness to turn your life and will unto my keeping that relief came to you."

In October, the Mid-Southern California Area will elect a new Delegate and Area Officers. Even numbered Districts may elect new District Committee Members and about half of our G.S.R.s will be elected for a two year term.

Our Area has grown somewhat. Contributions are up considerably and attendance has increased, but unfortunately at least half of our District have lost their Committee Members and the turn over of G.S.R.s is unbelievable.

There are a number of groups that have G.S.R.s but they do not attend their District Meetings, Assemblies, or do they serve their group for one reason or another!

Very few meetings or groups in clubs send representation or contributions to the services so very vital to our fellowship.

I thought for a long while that not too many people were willing to serve, but I was wrong....I have discovered our Fellowship is 100% willing, 10% are willing to serve and 90% are willing to let them. We're not unlike the Bluebirds, Scouts, or Little League in many ways. We enjoy the benefits but not too interested in much involvement or responsibility.

It has been my observation over the years that long time sobriety goes hand in hand with service to our Fellowship.

A number of years ago the Director of the Harbor Area H. & I. Committee would announce at every meeting "the only excuse I'll take for missing a prison panel is dying on the way up there." BLACK NIGHT is a dreaded word around an Institutional Committee. Unfortunately the same importance is not applied to Intergroup or General Service.

There was much emphasis placed on service a few years back by home groups. Today many of our members do not belong to a home group.

How much time is involved in being a group G.S.R....Let's see...One District Meeting a month- 2 hours X 12 months - 24 hours. Four Assemblies a year X 6 hours - 24 hours. Perhaps 2 hours a month preparing a report for your group and research, which adds up to another 24 hours a year. So that totals up to about 3 days. That's not too much to give to a Fellowship that gives us 365 sober days a year.

The problem isn't just with groups, meetings, clubs and general overall apathy. A part of the problem is in our District Meetings and our Assemblies. Too many long reports ( I'm guilty of that ) by Area Officers, and those in attendance. I'm sure an Area inventory would help.

In my opinion for the General Service Structure to grow strong and function for what it was intended, resides in the Districts and the District Committee Member. A good District Committee Member is sober, dedicated, knowledgeable, enthusiastic, open-minded, willing, loving, and has enough time to do the job. "WHAT AN ORDER" - Surely all of us know people that have those qualifications!! You have them....use them! Do your group a service, do your Area a service, do yourself a service. 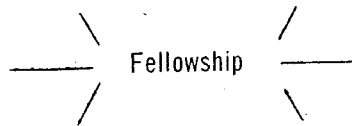

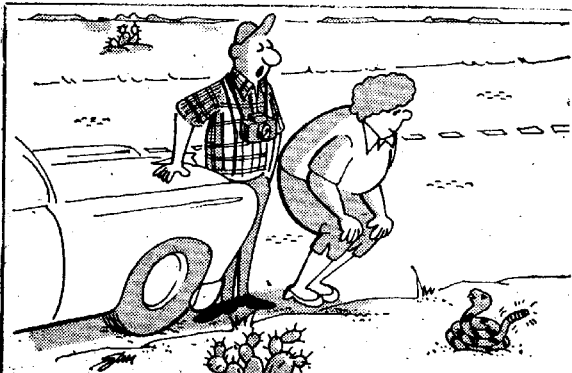
