## AA Roulette



Have you been dry for quite a long time? Is AA becoming a little boresome, something that is certainly needed by most of the group, but in your case has probably served its purpose? Do you secretly believe that, with all the knowledge you now have of alcoholics and alcoholism, you could probably handle the stuff; are you perhaps toying with the idea that some day, when time and place and all other factors are just right, you may TRY IT AGAIN?

If those are your conscious or subconscious thoughts, if you feel that another try at the bottle might be a pleasant thrill, why don't you try, instead, the thrill of Russian Roulette? You know... that game where you put only one bullet in a revolver, spin the cylinder, point the thing at your temple and pull the trigger?

The odds in Russian Roulette are very much in favor of the player; four chances out of five no harm whatever would be done (not even a hangover). Of course there is that fifth chance... that ONE chance that would mean disaster... curtains... the end... but the chances are, four out of five, that wouldn't happen to you on the first try.

Now, you think that's silly? You think only a moron would do such a thing;

and what does that have to do with your taking a drink anyway? Here's what it has to do with it, my fellow alky; you're planning a much more foolish and dangerous game--you're going to play AA Roulette.

In AA Roulette, you must (mentally) select four other players who are "good AAs" with long periods of sobriety behind them. You would bet your last dollar that not one of them would take a drink--ever. But, for the sake of this game, we'll presume they have the same idea in mind that you have, that they could take a drink or two without doing any particular harm. Although you think YOU could do it, you don't believe THEY could; you've learned too much about alcoholics to believe that. Well, if you've forgotten how to look at yourself honestly, let's look at you through their eyes: THEY don't believe YOU could do it, either. So the consensus indicates that each of the five will get drunk and not one of them will emerge from the spree a controlled drinker, after pulling the trigger and taking that first drink.

So what? Five good AAs, who have grown to appreciate their sobriety, each have a slip. What harm has been done, that is, to the individuals themselves?

The chances are that one or two of them will come back into AA with no apparent harm having been done at all, perhaps even stronger for having learned a lesson the hard way. We'll stretch a point, for the purpose of this game, and say that such happens to four out of five. But according to the law of averages as we have witnessed it over the years, it just doesn't stand to reason that five out of five of these AA stalwarts will make the grade. At least one of the five will never come back and his slip will eventually end in disaster or death. At least one of those five is now having his last chance at sobriety. You probably agree with that premise, but "It wouldn't happen to me," you say. . . . and "wouldn't happen to me" echoes in four other minds. The grim consensus again indicates that not one of the five has a better chance than any one of the other four.

Of course, the odds are it wouldn't be you; four chances out of five, perhaps, this isn't your absolutely final opportunity for sobriety; four chances out of five a slip for you wouldn't mean death or disaster.

Do you want to pull the trigger and find out? I don't.

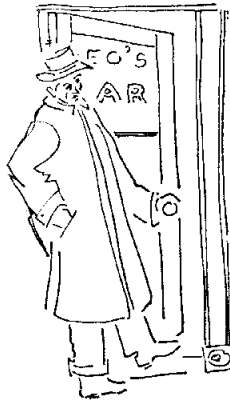

**THE THICK-SKINNED DRUNK** who will go back repeatedly to joints he's been thrown out of

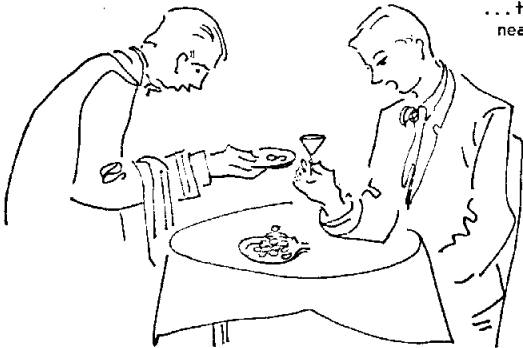

**THE EXCITING PERSONALITY** who tells you all about yourself.



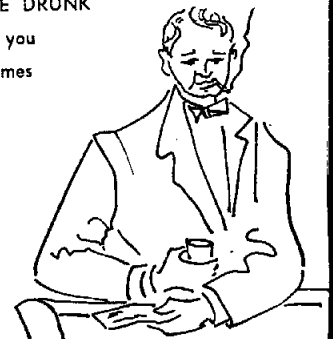
**THE SLOPPY DRUNK** who eats those olives.

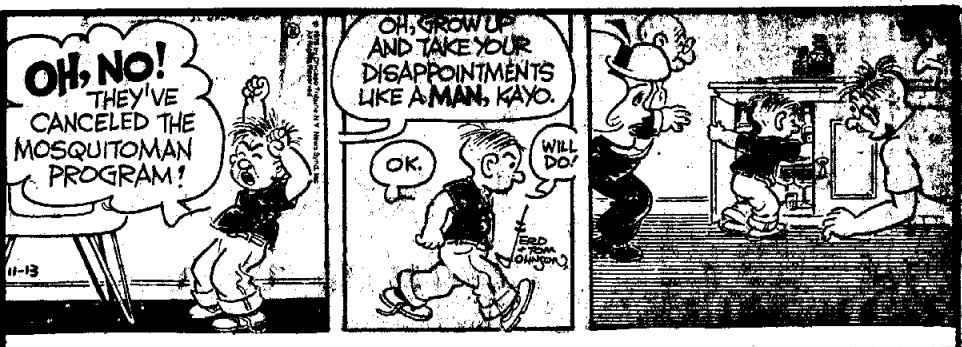

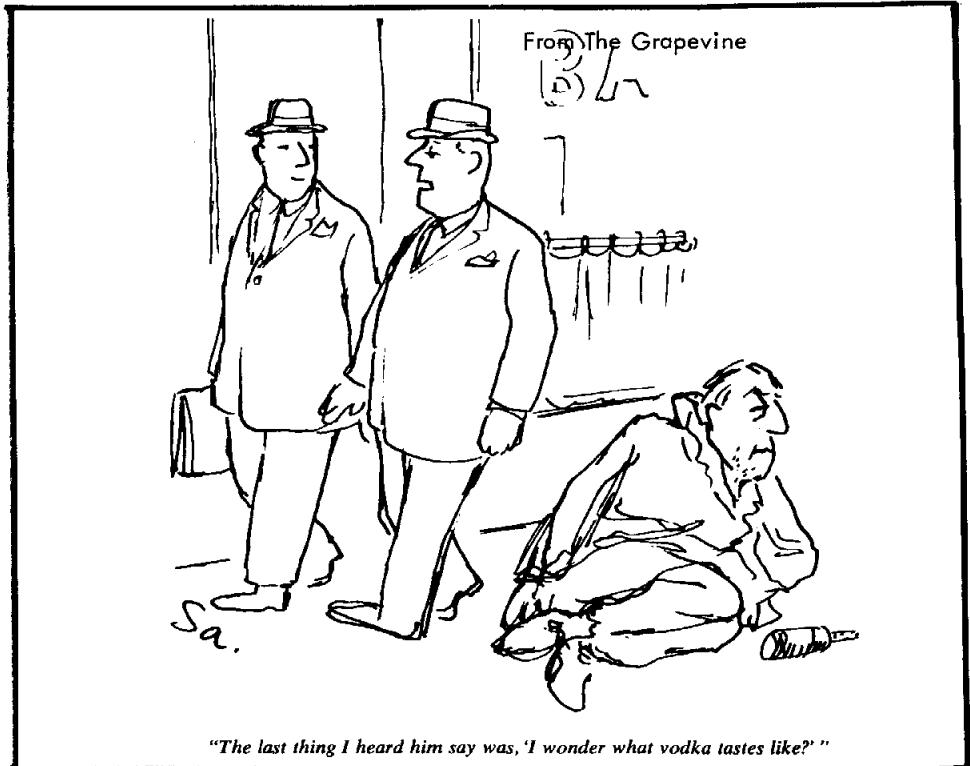

## DELEGATE'S MESSAGE.....

One of the things that made my trip to New York to attend the General Service Conference more meaningful this past April was leaving a few days early in order to have time to spend at the General Service Office and in particular the Archives Department. It is difficult to describe the feeling that came over me while thumbing through the first edition of our Big Book with all the autographs of the early A.A. members along with autographs of many non-alcoholic friends who played such an important part in our A.A. history. Old photos, newspaper clippings, the early literature and the Lasker Award were some of the items that made such a lasting impression on me.

Our General Service Office is encouraging the formation of Archives throughout the various areas in the United States and Canada so that our history might be recorded and myth will never predominate over fact. To accomplish this in the Mid-Southern-California Area our Assembly voted to join the Southern California Archives Committee which has already collected much information and material regarding the early days in Southern California. We will be looking for those old timers who were part of A.A.'s beginning in the various cities throughout Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino and Southern Los Angeles Counties.

The Conference Public Information Committee recommended that production be started as soon as possible on new television and radio spots. The TV spots will have sign language or subtitles for the deaf. Also Spanish speaking TV and radio spots are to go into production.

A new hard cover book is in the making which will include the "Best" articles appearing in the Grapevine over the past 35 years. Much research is being done in this effort.

After listening to tapes of our Big Book made by various individuals, the decision was made that G.S.O. will produce a master tape of our book in order to eliminate some of the reading errors (word omissions, substitutions, etc.) noted in the existing tapes. Work is in progress on this and tapes should be available to the Fellowship in the near future to be sold on a non-profit basis.

1980 will be a busy year. In addition to the International Convention to be held in New Orleans in July, the Pacific Region A.A. Service Assembly will be held in Anaheim at the "Inn at the Park" on February 29-March 1 and 2. This will be a great opportunity for the members living within Mid-Southern California Area to take part in a truly great experience. We won't have the same opportunity for a very long time. In 1981 we will have to travel to Kodiak, Alaska to have the same experience. In September, 1980 the Pacific Region will again host a Regional Forum in Phoenix, Arizona.

Some interesting statistics given at the Conference show the growth of our Fellowship starting in 1935 with 2 members and 0 groups to an active membership of 627,456 and 33,241 groups at the end of 1978. 149,336 of these members are overseas meeting in 8,737 groups. There are presently 24 overseas General Service Offices and literature distribution centers with 9 of them being Spanish speaking countries. The two-millionth copy of "Alcoholics Anonymous" has just been presented to Health, Education and Welfare Secretary Joseph Califano by Bill's widow, Lois Wilson. It took 34 years to sell the first million copies but only 5 years to reach the two-million mark.

It would appear that A.A. is alive and well at the end of our first 44 years!

Free shuttle bus service will be provided from participating hotels to the Superdome on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. A past delegate's luncheon and a central office luncheon will be held.

It's give to this and give to that. Perhaps that's part of the recovery. I

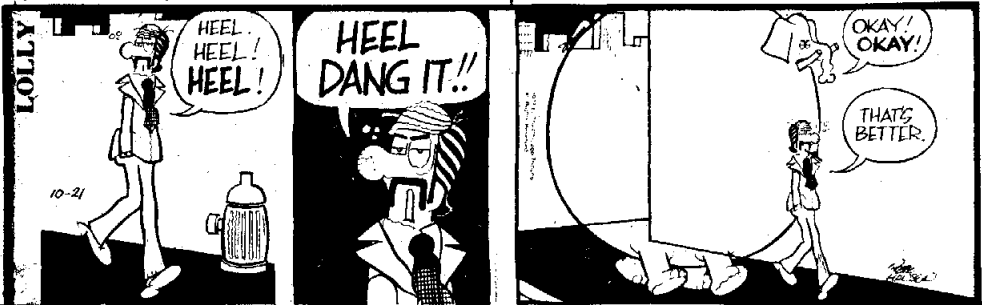

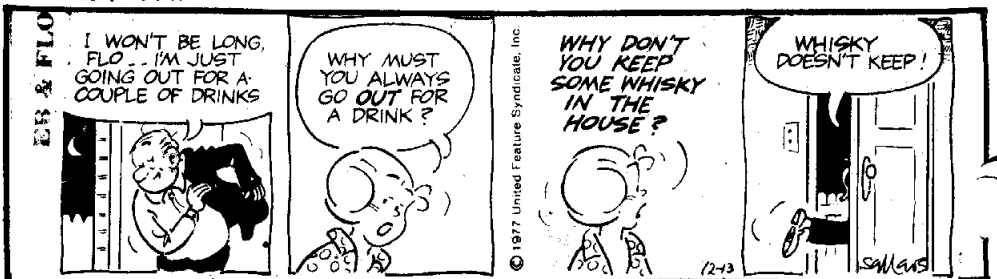
