ELECTION....

Some of your trusted servants are about to leave office. At least six of us on the Intergroup Service Board will come to the end of our terms in November.

At the same time, at least six new Board members will be elected by your Intergroup Representatives and begin the important job of helping to keep your Central Office alive and well during the coming year.

Intergroup By-Laws require that you will begin nominations from the floor for the new Service Board members at our October Intergroup Meeting. Will YOUR Rep be there to nominate some reasonable person? That person must have at least two years of continuous sobriety. It helps if he or she is an intergroup rep or knows something about the how and why of Intergroup, or the Central Office, but those are not requirements- just suggestions.

Remember, any one of us is welcome at any Intergroup Meeting. You will help all of us if you mention the October and November Meetings in your own regular Group meeting and make certain that you are represented. Your regular rep will already have some ideas about responsible individuals who might serve on our Board. Help her- or him- with your suggestions.

Intergroup Service Board people work for all Orange County alcoholics. They supervise the Central Office, hire professional personnel, raise funds, safeguard those funds, help keep the telephone answering service going, see that Lifeline is published, manage the circulation of AA publications to groups, send speakers to schools, communicate with the media and the County at large, run the calendar of Special Events, and much, much more.

Service Board people are usually overworked and enthusiastic people. They care. And they reflect the growing list of industrious, and above all SOBER caring alcoholics who serve others in Orange County.

Nominations on Tuesday, October 9th. Election on Tuesday, November 13th.

Both regular meetings begin at 8 P.M. at the Central Office, 2712 South Grand Ave., Santa Ana.

HAVE FILM - WILL TRAVEL!!!

The new film, "Alcoholics Anonymous - An Inside View", is now in the Mid-Southern California Area for an extended period of time. This is the first AA-made film intended for public showing. The 28 minute color film, portraying the joy of sober living, features AAs in candid unrehearsed scenes, using careful filming techniques to maintain our tradition of anonymity. The 29th General Service Conference approved the film but with limitations in distribution during the first year. AA World Services will retain ownership of the film and control distribution of each copy. The film is to be released only to those with an expressed, direct interest in helping the sick alcoholic. AA Service entities such as Public Information and Institutional Committees have first priority. A brief evaluation (on a prepared form) is to be submitted to G.S.O. with each showing and the results of the evaluation and distribution policy will be reviewed during the 1980 General Service Conference by the Conference Public Information Committee.

If you are interested in setting up a meeting to show the film, please contact me at 714-682-1019.

It will soon be that time of year when groups are asked to update the information that appears in the World Directory. You may wish to check the copy your group has on its literature table to see if the information is correct. It appears the same year after year unless changes are sent to G.S.O. If your group does not have a copy---chances are the contact listed in the directory for your group is no longer valid or your group may not be registered with G.S.O.

Each year the Delegate is sent a form for each group (called a print-out) showing the current information G.S.O. has on each group. These print-outs, which number about 700 in the Mid-Southern California Area, are then distributed by the Delegate to the District Committee Members. The Committee Members, with the help of the G.S.R.s in each district then make the necessary changes on the print-outs which are then returned to G.S.O. via the Delegate.

The Mid-Southern California Area will be making these changes during the last 2 weeks in October. If your group has mis-information in the 1979 World Directory, please take the responsibility of advising either your District Committee Member or myself of any changes that should be made. Obviously this is no easy task but if we all work together and use responsible members of the group for contacts, perhaps the 1980 edition of the World Directory will not be obsolete before it is published.

October 14 will be a big day in our Area! Every AA group within the Mid-Southern California Area has the privilege of casting their vote for a Delegate to represent them at the General Service Conference for the next 2 years. The Election Assembly will be held at the Knights of Columbus Hall, 740 Pennsylvania Avenue in Colton starting at 10:00 A.M. In addition to choosing a new Delegate, we will also be electing the Alternate Delegate, Area Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary. These trusted servant positions will be filled from the members of the Area Committee (District Committee Members and Area Officers).

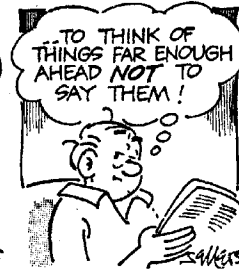
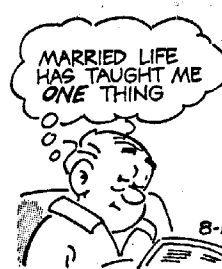

12. FOR COMPLETION BY PUBLISHERS MAILING AT THE REGULAR RATES (Section 132.121, Postal Service Manual)

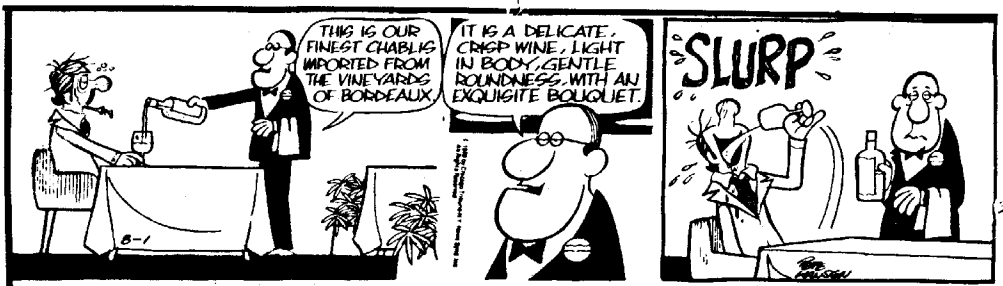
