"You never did let go!!"

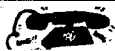

Some highlights from the report of the Fall General Service Board deliberations:

The Finance Committee reviewed reports for the nine months ending September 30, (1979) and it was shown that literature sales have increased 23.4% over the same period in 1978, and most hearteningly, contributions increased 16.2%. Expenses increased 12% (.8% under budget) a figure which the Committee was very satisfactory in view of the increasing cost of doing business and the growth of the Fellowship.

The Chairman of the AAWS Board reported on the feasibility study of further reducing the cost of literature. Following a careful review of that report, the Finance Committee recommended that the AAWS Board allow no less than a 5% price reduction on the total amount of all orders in excess of \$25.00 to all purchasers within the Fellowship. Subsequently, at the November meeting of the AAWS Board a 6% price reduction of orders within the Fellowship in excess of \$25.00 was approved.

We are happy that our Pacific Region Trustee, George Dorsey, is a member of the Finance Committee.

The Literature Committee reports that the pamphlet for the elderly alcoholic, "Time to Start Living", is now in production and should be in distribution soon in our Area through the Central Offices. Completion of the audio tapes of the book, "Alcoholics Anonymous," is announced and these should also soon be available locally.

The new year signals the elections in our various entities of service. Many new Board members and Directors are assuming office in the five central offices, Long Beach, Orange County, South Coast, and Coachella Valley. Also in the five Hospital and Institutional Committees. New member of the Harbor Area Central Office Board is our own former District 1 General Service Committeeman, John J. Bill H., moves to Chairman. H & I in Harbor Area elected John M., as Director. Over in Inland Empire a former Long Beach resident, (now of Fontana) Bob B., is the new Vice Chairman of the Central Service Board. Five new members were elected to the Orange County Central Service Board- Lew W., Anaheim, Ray B., Garden Grove, Sheryl K., Tustin, Pat L., Sunset Beach, Bill C., San Juan Capistrano, and John L., Santa Ana elected to complete the unexpired term of a resigned member. Congratulations to all these and the others of which we have not been informed. We think AA service is the key to recovery and welcome all of you to your new challenges.

News about the agenda for the 1980 General Service Conference, theme of which is "Participation- the Key to Recovery", indicates these suggested topics: possible restructuring in some degree of the Conference and Boards which will be discussed in depth at a planned two-hour sharing session by the GS Conference Committee. It is to be called "How Well is the Conference Structure Working?" Results will be referred to the appropriate Committees for further study and submission to the 1981 Conference. Other presentations and discussion items on the agenda include: Reaching the Alcoholic by working with non-Alcoholics. Participation: Equal Voice-Equal Responsibility. The Right of Decision- Trusted Servants. Participation: Service and Recovery.

I am in the process of formulating the Questionnaire and you should have had the opportunity of participating in it by the time you read this. Thank you all for your cooperation in preparing and distributing this year's Questionnaire, it will be of inestimable help to me in New York.

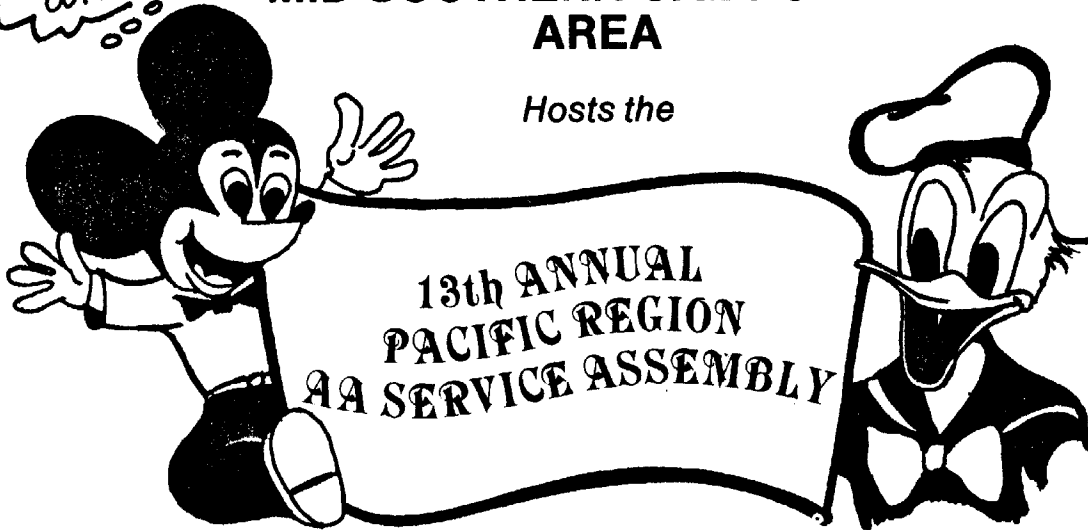

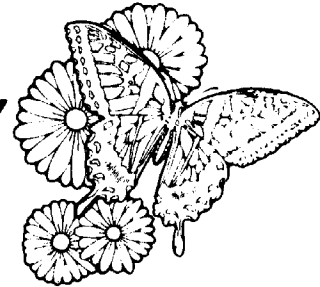

You said I'd get into trouble, but you wanted to go with me anyway. I told you that you were too little and you said if I didn't take you with me you would tell our parents, so I relented. Much later, you became tired and hungry so I carried you and I, too, became tired. I was lost and decided to ask someone where we were. It's really ego deflating and difficult to nonchalantly admit you don't know where you are.

You started to cry for Mother and wanted to go home. With tears brimming over large brown eyes and chubby pink cheeks, I took your hand in mine and told you that you were going to be all right and we were going home. A nice

lady gave you cookies and called the police. Feelings of fear, guilt and embarrassment assailed me as we were given police escort home.

Now, over forty years later, the ravages of time and the self-inflicted, loneliest of diseases, alcoholism, has taken its toll on you. Depleted physically mentally and spiritually, you wander aimlessly on the streets of Nowhere, pursued by the ghosts of yesterday and nameless dreads and fears of the future. Full of fear, guilt-ridden, with remorse, rejection, self-pity and self-delusion your constant companions.

I weep inside when I know where you have been, because I've been there also. I, too, suffered the same soul-sickness, driven by self-will, self-destruction and retaliation, with alcohol my 'go power, until my get up and go got up and went. It ceased to work for me anymore. Consistently inconsistent, on an emotional teeter-totter, on the brink of insanity and death, I surrendered to a power bigger than I, that I came to be-

lieve was God! When self-will blocks my spiritual contact, I talk with God and surrender again, my will, to become willing again to "Let go and Let God".

Now, once again, I'm asking you, Joanne, to please take my hand and rise above the bottomless pit of despair, drugs, alcohol, insanity and death, towards life, love, sobriety, sanity, and serenity that passes all understanding. Take my love, until you can learn to forgive and love yourself. Use my strength and hope until you feel God's power and His love returning within you, that is in each and every one of us.

Stand up and be counted--as God's children we crawl before no one. He loves you unconditionally, with no strings attached. Believe as I truly believe that you're going to make it and you're going to be all right, returning, once again home in the warmth of God's glowing love.....Liz S.
