Only about 100 of the Questionnaires have reached me but several things appear to be quite obvious. We have not had time as yet to completely analyze the trends and make a complete report, question by question. We shall try to have this done by the first of April.

In the meantime here are some group conscience feelings. It seems that few of our groups in MSCA have steering committees, and relatively few have representatives at the Intergroup or Assembly level. There is little or no group activity for the Grapevine nor for Public Information-Communication with the Professional Community work. This latter is left to the Intergroups in the area. Most AA members in our area feel that no compensation of any sort for any type of committee work should be given. Speakers should pay their own way. Most group jobs are filled through volunteers and with little advice as to what the responsibilities entail. It is very evident that most people believe that Clubs should not be given the Group Discount when purchasing literature for resale. The use of last names should be a personal choice in AA and certainly so outside the Fellowship was the general concern.

Thank all of you for taking the time to help me learn how you and your groups feel. I shall go to the Conference prepared to reflect what I believe to be the Group Conscience on the topics discussed, even though response was small.....Denver C., Area Delegate

SHARING IS CARING

SIT DOWN! SHUT UP! LISTEN! MAKE MEETINGS! AND GET A FRIEND! . . .

I first came to AA 5 years ago. I still hadn't surrendered. How could anyone like me surrender to anything good. I saw things though! I was still able to recognize love. Love frightened me, because though I desired it greatly, I always seemed to abuse it.

I saw Ralph. An elderly man, with snow white hair and an appearance of pride in the ability to love. I loved this man from afar.

Ralph would give his qualification in all simplicity. Sharing the fundamentals of the disease, his entrance into A.A., and gradually from the time he started speaking, his childlike manner seemed to be sending a breeze that was cool and refreshing to the soul, and grew to a point where I felt like I was hang gliding thru the most beautiful simple country in the world. Now I've never been hang gliding but I know exactly what it's like. To feel the freedom and simplicity of a bird from listening to Ralph. And the funny thing is you don't land with a crash. Actually you just seem to bring new heights and horizons to the ground with you. I just seemed to be able to look up instead of trudging down. Ralph and I and many others I have met in A.A. do not "trudge down the happy road of destiny." Now prior to coming to AA I had tried to kill my father on three occasions. I was at the peak of defiance, despair self-hate, etc.

"Ask a man to help?" "Get a sponsor?" I followed Ralph around for 8 1/2 months loving him from afar, and I imagine him talking to me with the simplicity of love that generated from him. "Go ahead, Eddie. Ask him to be your sponsor"- "Oh God, must I?" I think I'll die if I do! I'm just about positive he wouldn't say no. He's too good a man to do that to someone." I felt like I had to ask someone to be my father. Me! Mister self-sufficient! Never asked anybody for anything! Was a father to myself all my life and a big brother to seven younger brothers and sisters. Ask a man for help? Oh, God! Must I? God, though I wanted to. You see I always wanted the best for myself all my life in whatever it was. If I was able to do this sponsorship business it was going to be Ralph, because I still wanted the best. Before I started drinking, I was going to be either the

best doctor, or lawyer or priest-or bum. Now I could see that this thing was a spiritual answer to a physical disease and I wanted the best.

Anyway still unemployed, and after talking to Ralph after a daytime meeting, I was invited by Ralph to His apartment for coffee. "This is the opportunity to ask him!!" "Are you crazy?" "I can't do it. I can't do it!" "Force yourself!" Sitting at the table trying to scrape up the exact way to ask him, suffering the torment of the damned, I was looking at Ralph who was at total peace, enjoying my company!

Well, rather than going into a convulsion, I spit it out. "Ralph! I got something to ask you! I'd like you to be my sponsor!" 3 second pause and then in a disappointing tone of voice, he said, "No, Eddie." Oh, God! This can't be happening! I almost died doing this! He's got to have a reason. He's too beautiful a person to do this to me! For once in my life, I was right! Because I looked at Ralph and with a smile that said, "Joy, eyes that said 'Love' and an aura that said "Peace! He said, "Eddie, I'll do better than that. I'll be your friend." After being mentally rejected by my father who shared nothing but sadistic things with me, and drinking myself into a personality that all I ever wanted to do was stay away from, I meet this man who wants to share love with me in a real sense.

I'm glad Ralph's not my sponsor. I might have felt that I was under someone's thumb. You see, Ralph and I feel that a friend will have more of an influence on a person, then someone who might feel they have to do the right thing for a person all the time. He makes all the suggestions that a sponsor makes, but he speaks as a friend. I can accept or reject his suggestions. I usually accept because I know he cares. I even make suggestions to him, and you know something he chooses to accept quite often because he knows I care about him. You see, he knows I'm not what I chose to believe I was and that I have something to offer.

I've yet to abuse Ralph's love, because I have found a gift that was like an oasis on a desert. And the more I drink from it, the stronger I am to add to the oasis and build it up. I appreciate this oasis and I give to it, and you

know something it's getting more beautiful each and every day.

So am I. . . . Love, Your friend, Eddie. P.S. I'm sending my father beautiful cigar right now that I know he enjoys.
