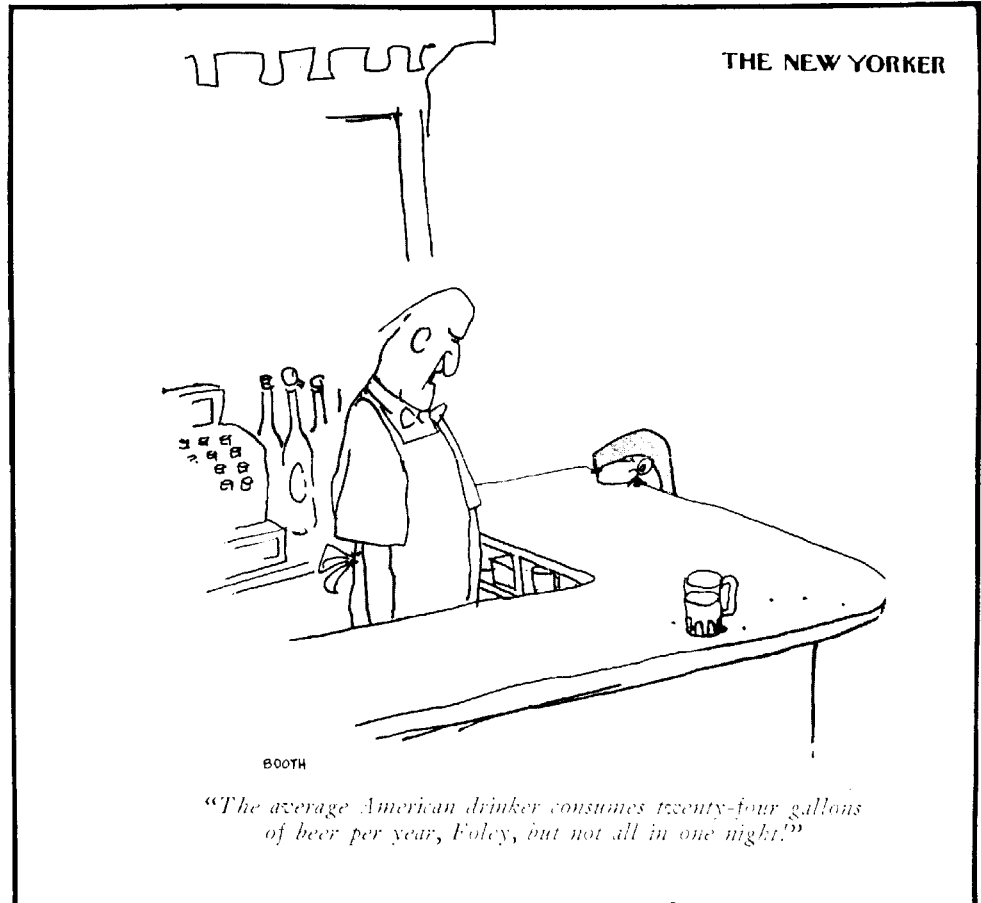
for instance? Chances are he or she would be saying goodbye before we had a chance to say hello.

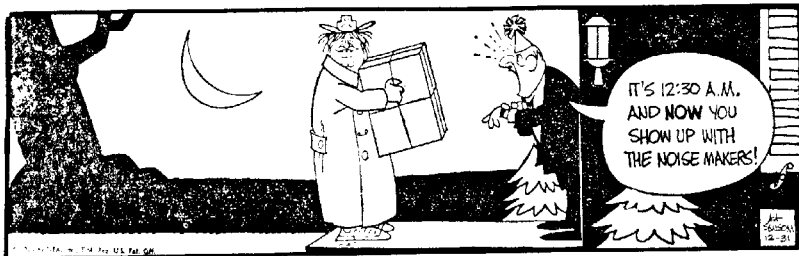

60-30-10 Plan

To support A.A.'s essential services, the General Services Conference recommends that groups follow the "60-30-10" plan. It works like this:

First, take care of basic group expenses, (rent, refreshments and A.A. literature. Divide remaining funds as follows:

60% to your intergroup of Central Office

To support phone service for 12th Step calls and other inquiries; coordination of group activities; and A.A. literature sales.

30% to your General Service Office. To support group services throughout the U.S. Canada.; the General Service Conference;

helping lone members and groups in institutions; and carrying the A.A. message worldwide.

10% to your Area Committee. To support area assemblies, delegates' expenses and area public information and institution work.

THE ANNUAL TRADITIONS BANQUET which is anticipated by many members of AA in the Harbor Area was well attended this year and we sincerely hope it realized its stated purpose "to raise some funds for the NY Office of AA." This represents the annual contribution from the Harbor Area Central Office each year and is a good purpose, in addition to bringing a goodly number of recovering alcoholics together for food, fun, dancing and to hear a good recovery message from an AA member and an Al-Anon member. This year we heard our beloved Chuck and Elsa.

As an additional fringe benefit each person had an opportunity to get a copy of an interesting history of AA in the Harbor Area which is written and compiled by Flossie L., who instituted the first Central Office in Long Beach on May 14, 1948 with the assistance of her husband, Clarence, and the hearty cooperation of the nine regular groups in the area at that time: Bowling Green, Signal Hill, Westside, 20-40, North Long Beach, Mother, East Bay, San Pedro and Wilmington. Thus began Central AA Service in the Long Beach home of an Al-Anon and an Alcoholics Anonymous member.

We constantly hear of Anonymity breaks throughout the Mid-Southern California Area at the level of press, radio and film and all of us in service at almost any level of such activity, be it Central Office, Hospital and Institutional committees, General Service committees, Public Information and Cooperation with the Professional Community committees and in speaking personally before AA groups as well as outside groups maintain the tradition and practice of personal anonymity. However, there are notable exceptions. Many breaks are through ignorance of the tradition and of its value to us in our recovery. Other breaks many times seem to be an ego problem on the part of those who break their personal anonymity. Still others use AA as a means of some personal gain, either intentionally or caselessly. We all owe it to AA and the society and its program which saved our lives to respect anonymity, our own, others, and to the program itself where it appears necessary. This is invariably a good discussion topic in discussion meetings.

This is the time of year when rotation of jobs in our committees at all levels occupies the attention of a great many of us. Elections are being held to all sorts of AA committees, new people being given opportunities to serve, trusted servants in amny cases being returned because no one "wants the job". But for me one of the better side benefits of sobriety has been the chance to serve. It helps us learn humility, gratitude, more about AA as a whole, and enriches our lives in countless ways. If you are asked to serve, take the opportunity and the experience will likely help in ways you never expected.

"A NEWCOMER ASKS" is the newest AA General Service Conference approved pamphlet. This originated in England as AA literature and has been released to World Service for use in the U.S. and Canada (and world wide). It is very definitely prepared for the newcomer to easily understand. Ten questions are presented which are those most often asked by a person newly into the program or "researching" it. The second question dealt with, we liked especially. "How Can This Help Me with My Drinking Problem?"

"We in AA know what it is like to be addicted to alcohol, and to be unable to keep promises made to others and ourselves that we will stop drinking. We are not professional therapists. Our only qualification for helping others to recover from alcoholism is that we have stopped drinking ourselves, but problem drinkers coming to us know that recovery is possible because they see people who have done it." The pamphlet is available at your AA Central Office for ten cents a copy.

"Dr. Bob commented on the Eleventh Tradition as follows:"

"Since our Tradition on anonymity designates the exact level where the line should be held, it must be obvious to everyone who can read and understand the English language that to maintain anonymity at any other level is definitely a violation of this Tradition."

The A.A. who hides his identity from his fellow A.A. by using only a given name violates the Tradition just as much as the A.A. who permits his name to appear in the press in connection with matters pertaining to A.A."

"The former is maintaining his anonymity above the level of press, radio and films, and the latter is maintaining his anonymity below the level of press, radio and films---whereas the Tradition states that we should maintain our anonymity at the level of press, radio and films."
