MESSAGE FROM YOUR DELEGATE.....

THIS MONTH'S MAIL FROM General Service Office in New York included the very excellent treatise on one of the better known efforts to aid in the recovery of alcoholics. It is entitled "The Washingtonian Movement" and was written by Dr. Milton A. Maxwell, Ph.D., Chairman of the Board of Trustees. Tracing the history of the movement from its inception by six drinking friends on April 2, 1840 who were gathered together drinking in Chase's Tavern on Liberty Street in Baltimore. They were William K. Mitchell, a tailor; John F. Hoss, a carpenter; David Anderson and George Steers, both blacksmiths; James McCurley, a coachmaker; and Archibald Campbell, a silversmith. They fell to discussing a temperance lecture to be given that evening by a visiting lecturer, the Rev. Matthew Hale Smith. Jokingly, they proposed that some of them attend and report back. Four went and on their return, all discussed the lecture. On Sunday, April 5, again drinking, they decided to organize a total abstinence society. Mitchell became president; Campbell, vice-president; Hoss, secretary; McCurley, treasurer; and Steers and Anderson, the standing committee. Membership fee was twenty-five cents, monthly dues twelve and a half cents. One of the more interesting things was that each man agreed to bring another man to the next meeting.

THE FOLLOWING PLEDGE was formulated and signed: "We, whose names are annexed, desirous of forming a society for our mutual benefit, and to grand against a pernicious practice which is injurious to our health, standing and families, do pledge ourselves as gentlemen that we will not drink and spiritous or malt liquois, wine or cider." And thus was born the Washington Temperance Society, more commonly referred to as the Washingtonians.

AT THE FIRST anniversary of the society on April 5, 1841, there were about 1,000 reformed drunkards and 5,000 other members and friends who paraded to celebrate the occasion. Some 40,000 residents of Baltimore were greatly impressed at witnessing the event.

The first meeting of the society in New York was Tuesday, March 23, 1841 in a Methodist church on Green Street. Five speakers, all "reformed drunkards" deeply moved and inspired those who came to hear and more than a hundred pledges were signed amid unaffected tears and with cordial greetings by the five Baltimore delegated who spoke.

Meetings were held in Boston (The first on April 15, 1841) to larger crowds and the movement began to spread rapidly. By May 1842 the Boston society claimed 13,000 members and many chapters began to appear throughout New England.

Dr. Maxwell's pamphlet continues the story of the Washingtonians and his history is a distinct contribution to the archives of AA. I suggest if you wish a copy please call me and I will try to advise you on how to get it. It is not on the regular literature lists as yet.

AT THIS TIME our records show over fifty new groups having been started since last year's Western Directory was made available. Please send me the information on new groups, making certain to include time and location of the meetings, name and type of meeting, and a GSR if available, as well as a contact name and telephone number to be listed. Also, please register your new groups in the Central Office nearest your location of meeting. In our area there are six: Inland Empire, Colton; All South Bay, Torrance; Central Office of the Desert, Palm Springs; Harbor Area, Long Beach; Orange County, SantanAna; and Victor Valley, Victorville.

I SHALL BE HAPPY TO give a Conference Report at any AA meeting in the Area after returning from New York. Several commitments have already been scheduled and I will do my best to share it all with you. Thank you all for allowing me to share.

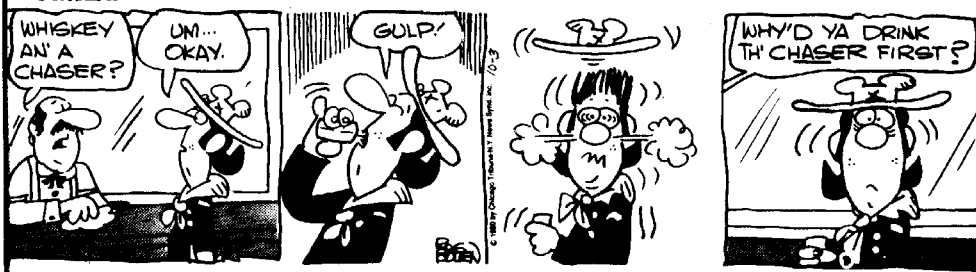

# Hospital & Institution Conference

Cooperation between A. A. and other organizations and institutions in helping the confined alcoholic will be the focus of the ninth annual Statewide Hospital and Institution Conference which will be held in Fresno May 8, 9 and 10.

More than 800 A.A. members, volunteers and professionals from throughout the state are expected to attend the conference and participate in workshops, panels and discussions aimed at cooperation among all who are trying to help alcoholics confined in hospitals and institutions.

While the California conference dates back only to 1972, the idea of cooperation with professionals in the field originated more than 20 years ago in an article Bill W. wrote for Grapevine.

After discussing the work in alcoholism of the Yale Group, the National Council on Alcoholism, the thousands of public and private hospitals, industry, judges, American Medical Association and other organizations, Bill said:

"So let us work along side all these projects of promise to hasten the recovery of those millions who have not yet found their way out. These varied labors do not need our special endorsement; they need only a helping hand when, as individuals, we can possibly give it."

Both the goals of the conference and participation as individuals in the weekend meeting are entirely in keeping with the 11th Tradition of A.A. which states that "Our public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio and films."

As the book, "Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions" says, "Without its legions of well-wishers, A.A. could never have grown as it has. Throughout the world, immense and favorable publicity of every description has been the principal means of bringing alcoholics into our fellowship . . . It is no exaggeration to say that half of A.A.'s membership has been led to us through channels like these..."

The California conference got its beginning in 1973 when 485 A.A.'s and professionals from hospitals, penal institutions, correctional facilities, courts, etc., gathered in Stockton. Delegates met in Bakersfield for the second meeting in 1975 and since then, all the conferences have been in Fresno. There was no meeting in 1974.

During the years, the conference has developed a policy statement which has three main goals:

1. To improve mutual understanding and cooperation between A.A. and the non-alcoholic professionals in an effort to help the confined alcoholic.
2. To improve understanding and cooperation between institutions and A.A. through workshops, panels and general discussion.
3. "To be friendly with our friends." In doing so, A.A. members experienced in such cooperation report three gratifying results:
  - a. It helps us to stay sober.
  - b. It often attracts alcoholics into A.A.
  - c. It helps non-alcoholics to gain understanding of and respect for our fellowship.
