- e. **Secretary:** Brittany (fill in) – Minutes for the most recent Intergroup Body Meeting are usually posted within one week after the meeting on the OC-AA.org website under *Member Services-Central Office-Intergroup Docs.*
- f. **Treasurer:** Ryan H. – Donations are up \$1,900 this month. Annual audit is coming up. \$106 collected today. Question from a member of the body, George – there was a 1200% increase in intergroup expenses this month YOY. Why such a large increase? Richard had a question – is the audit once per year? Yes, it is annual audit. Maddie question – who is the auditor? CliftonLarsonAllen – how much of an increase is the \$1,900 as a percentage? \$23,000 income this month \$21,000 income from the past month. That’s a 10% increase. We are hovering about our prudent reserve every month (the prudent reserve is 4-6 months – around \$190k. Another question from the body – what is the breakdown of donations vs. the zoom meetings? The zoom meetings contribute substantially less than in person meetings.
- g. **Lifeline:** Matt D.- May lifeline is live. Copies were available at the meeting. Skip has extra at Central Office. You can always get a electronic version at oc-aa.org.
